To the Rt. Hon^{ble}. HENRY Earl of Clarendon & Rochester, Viscount Cornbury. Viscount Hyde of Kenelworth, Baron Hyde of Hindon & Baron of Wotton Bassett:

This Prospect is Humbly Inscribed by,

My Lord, Ye Lordship's most Obed^t. humble Serv^{ts}. Sam^l. & Nath^l. Buck

THIS Castle was built by Galfridus de Clinton Chamberlain to K. Hen: his Nephew succeeding him, and having no Issue, sold it to K. Hen: III: who gave it to Simon Montford E: of Leicester; who marry'd Eleanor his sister; w^{ch}. Rebelling against the King was slain, and this Castle endured six months Siege, w^{ch}. In the end was surrendered, & by the King annexed as an inheritance to Edm^d. his Son E: of Lancaster; 2 Eliz: gave it to Robert Dudley E: of Leicester; who bestowed much cost in repairing and adorning it; which is now in the possession of the E: of Clarendon & Rochester:
